MAIN PURPOSE

To ensure that parents and carers of children with additional needs are fully engaged and involved in strategic planning and service developments related to Children and Young People with a disability or additional needs in Suffolk.

SUMMARY OF RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

1. The role of parent representatives (reps) is to inform decision makers about the experiences of parents and to ensure that parents' views are fed into decisions about children's services at an operational or strategic level. Through this process parents and professionals reach a common understanding and their combined information and perspectives result in joint planning that leads to more effective services.
